In 2015, the first year of the American Legion Run, \$8,400 provided a newly renovated hospice room at the Grand Rapids Home for Veterans.

In 2016, the second year of the American Legion Run, \$5,838 provided 11 complete computers to the Grand Rapids Home for Veterans.

In 2017, \$5,000 was given to Wilwin Lodge at Cygnet Cove in Custer, Michigan, to help build one of many cabins in Veterans Village needed for PTSD and TBI (Traumatic Brain Injuries) veterans and their families.

And in 2018, \$10,000 of the money raised was given to Wilwin Lodge to help build one of the many cabins in Veterans Village.
